## Contest Rules

Competitors in the under 9 class will play one selection of their choice. Competitors in all other classes will play a waltz, a jig and a reel or breakdown or hornpipe, played in that order. There will be a 4 minute time limit for each performer.

Judges will award points on the following basis:

1. Time and Tempo – 25 points
2. Tone – 25 points
3. Style and Technique – 25 points
4. Accuracy – 25 points

**Accompanists:** Contestants are to use an accompanist. A pianist will be on site to perform with contestants, although contestants are allowed to bring their own accompanist if they so chose. The accompanist must play a chording instrument such as piano or guitar. The accompanist must only play chords and not the melody.

**Order of Playing:** The order of playing will be decided by draw on the day of the competition.

**Ties:** In case of a tie, the two competitors involved will play one selection of their choice for the judges. A winner will be selected at that time.

**Group:** A group is defined as two or more fiddlers.

### **Prizes:**

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> will be awarded in each class

Best Reel/Breakdown/Hornpipe

Winners for all categories will be presented with medals. Cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

First place under 9 - \$20

First place 9-12 - \$50

First place 13-18 - \$80

First place 19-59 - \$100

First place 60+ - \$100

First place open - \$150
