What is the New Brunswick Highland Games Festival?

New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a provincial festival held annually since 1981. The mandate of the festival is to promote and increase the knowledge and participation of Scottish/Celtic culture through music, dance, genealogy, workshops, sport and food. The festival attracts thousands of visitors and competitors from all over Canada and the United States.





New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a festival that provides a venue for competition. Competitors, from across Canada and the United States and other points beyond, compete in bagpiping & drumming, highland dancing and Scottish traditional athletics (for both men and women) known as the 'Heavy Events'. Special for this July we will hosting the Atlantic Canadian Highland Dance Championships.

New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a festival where the public is invited to attend workshops in such diverse topics as piping, heavy events genealogy, Gaelic language and song, fiddling, chanter, *bodhràn*, whisky tasting, beer tasting, Scottish country dancing, ceilidh dancing, step dancing, Celtic life, and more. It is also a festival that showcases Celtic music in the traditional ceilidh and performance varieties.



New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a festival with special activities geared toward children. Special events are organized daily to give children the opportunity to have fun trying junior versions of the heavy events, craft making, face painting, mini golf and other special children's entertainment.



New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a festival where food vendors offer authentic Scottish delicacies and where craft vendors offer goods and souvenirs with a Celtic, Scottish and New Brunswick theme.



New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is a festival where the *Avenue of the Clans* provides advice and assistance in tracing family roots and encourages family/clan reunions.

New Brunswick Highland Games Festival is recognized by the Province of New Brunswick as a *Top Festival*, is the City of Fredericton's largest midsummer festival, is a festival that was twice named an "Attractions Canada Award" winner and is the only New Brunswick event listed in the American Bus Association's *Top 100 Events* in 2016.



10 Quick Facts about the New Brunswick Highland Games Festival

- 2017 marks the 36th New Brunswick Highland Games Festival.
- It is completely organized by a group of dedicated volunteers.
- It attracts approximately 8,000 spectators and competitors from across Canada and the United States.
- Visitors on average spend a minimum of 4 hours on the Games site.
- Nearly 60% of all visitors are repeat visitors.
- The event meets or exceeds the expectations of 99% of respondents.
- Approximately 74% of those who attend are between the ages of 18 and 60.
- It offers a Celtic 5K Run, traditional competitions and a wide array of Celtic entertainment and workshops for spectators.
- Competitors cite this as the best event of its kind in the Atlantic Region of Canada.
